For European students:

Copy of the European Health Insurance Card or an international insurance for the whole period of studies.

For Non-European students:

- For non-EU students staying < to 3 months: International Private Insurance for the whole period of studies;
- For non-EU students staying > 3 months: you must sign on (& pay) for the French student Social Security (215€ for 2015-2016 academic year).
 - Personal Civil Liability (also called "third-party damage"). It covers students for body injuries and for material damage caused to a third person.

Ecole d'Ingénieurs de PURPAN will register students to its insurance center MSA (Mutualité Sociale Agricole) for Work Accident: for internships & everyday travel from accommodation to school.

PURPAN also requires **Repatriation** coverage to the home country.
